The Expressive Therapies Continuum (ETC): Evaluation and treatment of eating disorders and substance use disorder

This conference is one of the activities offered in the psychotherapy continuing education program adopted by l'Ordre des psychologues du Québec. The recognition number is RA01792-16 (6 hours).

Dr. Lisa D. Hinz elaborated a practical, theoretical framework in art therapy called the Expressive Therapies Continuum (ETC) based on the works of Kagin and Lusebrink (1978). The ETC examines the therapeutic process with the help of image formation and by tapping into the physical, emotional, cognitive and creative aspects. You will learn to use this framework to evaluate and treat eating disorders and addiction problems while identifying the most common therapeutic errors and customizing art therapy treatment goals.

This hands-on workshop is for art therapists, creative arts therapists, students and any professionals in the fields of health and psychosocial services. The training session aims to provide participants with the tools to integrate and apply the ETC into their own clinical practice.

Lisa D. Hinz, Ph.D., ATR-BC, is an internationally renowned art therapist and psychologist, as well as a professor in the Art Therapy program she co-founded at Saint Mary-of-the-Woods College in Indiana. She is the author of many articles and the following books: *Expressive Therapies Continuum: A Framework for Using Art in Therapy* (2009) and *"Drawing from Within: Using Art to Treat Eating Disorders"* (2006).
